

Tuition fees and estimated ancillary costs for the MBA FM program

The MBA-Financial Management at Coburg University is a 4 semester (2-year) study program, including one term which is reserved for the 20-week mandatory internship.

Final degree: MBA Financial Management

The FM program has two possible entry points. Depending on the admission letter, it commences either in **Summer** Term (March 15th) or in **Winter** Term (October 1st) with a duration of 2 years.

The tuition fees currently amount to € 3.900,- /semester (total amount € 15.600,-). In addition, students are required to pay an enrollment fee of around 158 € every term. The details of the estimated living costs are provided in the following table.

Notes:

1. This budget assumes that the student is enrolled full time and will complete the degree program in the designated timeframe of four semesters.
2. Proof of sufficient funds to cover living costs (accommodation, food, insurance) have to be provided in the form of a blocked account (currently: 11.904,- € p.a.).
3. The MBA program includes a mandatory 20-week internship. Some students choose to do their internship in major hubs like Munich or Frankfurt. While rent and transportation in these cities are higher than in Coburg, the internship salary is designed to bridge this gap. Depending on the company, internships are remunerated between 1.700 – 2.600 €/month.
